These students and their families have been made aware that they are close contacts and will be in quarantine per the Health Department and CDC guidelines.

As always, we will be sanitizing the KND School District. Please know that this is done on a regular basis. Before we came back to school this fall, the District purchased two machines that are very effective at killing 99.99% of all germs. These devices are used every day. In addition, we have purchased two portable sanitizing machines that our bus drivers use on a daily basis. I mention this because I want our families to know that we do take the health and safety of your children very seriously.
