Dear Families,

Today we were made aware that one of our students in the high school tested positive for Covid-19. After conversations with the student and discussions with staff members, it was determined that this individual had been in close contact with some of their classmates.

Our day has been spent speaking with individuals directly impacted. We have contacted those students who have been deemed to be "close contacts." These individuals will be required to quarantine for 14 days, even if they receive a negative test.

As always, we will be sanitizing the KND School District. Please know that this is done on a regular basis. Before we came back to school this fall, the District purchased two machines that are very effective at killing 99.99% of all germs. These devices are used every day. In addition, we have purchased two portable sanitizing machines that our bus drivers use on a daily basis. I mention this because I want our families to know that we do take the health and safety of your children very seriously.
