Dear Families,

Yesterday, we were made aware of three staff members and three students who tested positive for Covid. They will remain in quarantine until Thursday, January, 27, 2022 according to Health Department and CDC guidelines. These positive cases resulted in ten close contacts. Of these close contacts, five will have to quarantine according to Health Department guidelines. They may return to school Thursday, January 27, 2022 if they are symptom-free.

To help protect your family from the negative effects of Covid-19, please consider the following information that is provided from the Health Department... 1. Fully vaccinated individuals deemed a closed contact do not have to quarantine as long as they are not experiencing symptoms. 2. Regardless of vaccination status, an individual wearing a mask properly and maintaining 3 feet of distance from the exposed individual, does not need to quarantine. 3. Students and staff not vaccinated, not wearing a mask, and are within 6 feet of an individual for 15 cumulative minutes who tests positive, will be quarantined for a minimum of 7 days.
